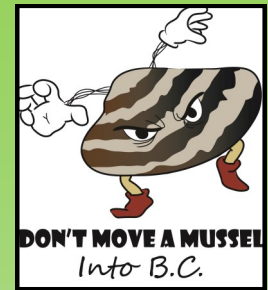


# The Christina Lake Stewardship Society Invites You To The Christina Lake Watershed Management Plan Annual Review—2015
